Clubs are expected to LOAD their own container(s), based on how many they purchased.

All containers will have a lid that must fit flat on top. No top/side bulging permitted.

Containers will be stacked two high.

Clubs will be monitored as they load to ensure no non-allowable items are packed.

Clubs must arrive/complete their packing in the time frame allowed (see above).

FLC is not responsible for transporting any Clubs gear if they miss the load location/date/time.

AUGUST 4, 2024

FLC will DELIVER your container(s) to your campsite in Gillette (Complex). And cover them with a plastic cover.

It is the Clubs responsibility to UNLOAD their container. Please do not disassemble it. Keep the plastic wrap.

It is the Clubs responsibility to keep the container in their campsite and in good condition to repack it.

AUGUST 11, 2024 – 9:00 am – IN GILLETTE

Each Club Must have their Container re-packed by 9:00 am, Sunday, August 11 at their campsite.

It is the Clubs responsibility to make sure their container(s) is packed and ready to load on time.

The Container will be picked up by FLC PAD and reloaded into the truck.

Each Club with containers MUST transport their tables, canopies, kitchen tent, poles, marked with the Club name to the designated site near your specific truck to hand load into the truck.

Containers MUST be loaded in a specific order / truck to be unloaded in the right location. Be on time. It matters.

AUGUST 18, 2024 -- FL UNLOAD DAY

All FLC Pathfinder Clubs MUST UNLOAD their Container in their ASSIGNED Location on this day.

FLC PAD IS NOT ABLE TO OR RESPONSIBLE TO STORE ANY CLUBS GEAR/CONTAINERS.

It is the responsibility of Pathfinder Club which purchased the Container(s) to reclaim their gear on time.

Plan ahead. Designate a person to oversee this.

If you have any issues – contact the person in charge of your Area.

Clubs may KEEP their Container, if they choose, but we will NOT re-use it in 2029 (next camporee).
